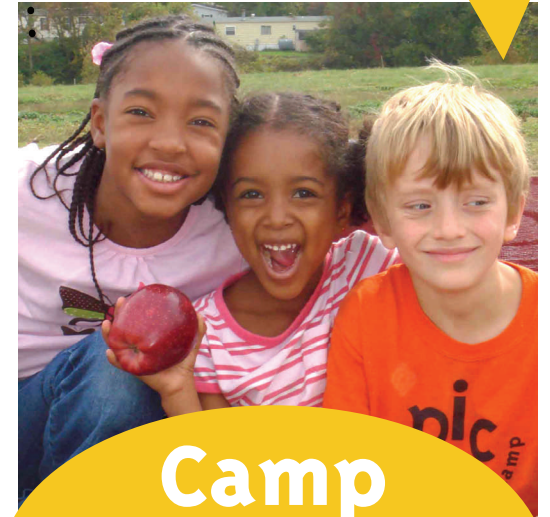

# Camp Kids' Place 2011



## Session 1: June 20 - July 1

### Constant Creativity — Inspire & Collaborate

Collaborative projects including artwork, comic books, costumes or cooking.

## Session 2: July 5 - July 15

### Splish-Splash — Water, Water Everywhere!

All kinds of water play, visits to Philadelphia Waterworks and Schuylkill River park, activities focused on nature, watershed animal life and conservation. Camp is closed July 4.

## Session 3: July 18 - July 29

### Sports Extravaganza — Camp Olympics

Traditional and non-traditional games. Build coordination and practice for a camp-wide Olympic competition.

## Session 4: August 1 - August 12

### Shining Stars — Dance, Drama and Song

Act out drama and comedy, learn songs and dances and put on a show for fellow campers, friends and family!

## Session 5: August 15 - August 26

### Around the World — Road Trip!

Explore various cultures through cooking, art, music. Field trips may include a museum trip, theater performance or other event.

**Who can attend?** Camp Kids' Place is for children entering grades K-5. Hours are Monday through Friday, 8am to 6pm. Children should arrive before 10am.

**What is the cost?** Each two-week session is \$440. Because of the July 4 holiday, Session 2 lasts nine days and costs \$390.

**Are discounts available?** Any camper who attends all 10 weeks will receive a 10% discount, which is applied to Session 5 tuition. Families with two or more children enrolled in PIC programs receive a 10% discount on the eldest child's tuition.

We welcome children enrolled in subsidized care. Call CCIS at 215-382-4762 to see if your family is eligible. Call NOW to ensure your subsidy is in place for summer.

### What if I need care for one week only?

The cost for one week is \$250. Individual weeks may not be combined into a two-week session.

**What about Girl Scouts?** We meet Girl Scouts at the bus stop and provide after-camp care at a rate of \$30 per week. To enroll, please register on the enrollment form.

# Enrollment

- To enroll in Camp Kids' Place, return the attached form along with a non-refundable application fee of \$35 and a tuition deposit of \$440. **Your deposit will be applied to your child's last two weeks of camp.** Application fee is waived for current PIC families.
- Upon receipt of the enrollment form, application fee and tuition deposit, we will send a packet of forms that must be completed and returned before your child comes to camp. A current (within 12 months) health form, signed by a physician, is required.
- Tuition for each additional session is due two weeks before the first day of the session.
- Cancellation Policy: If you cancel between April 15 and May 1, you will receive a 75% refund. If you cancel before May 27, you will receive a 50% refund. After that date, payment is required for all sessions reserved even if your child does not attend.
