Build a strong community of families at PIC by promoting social activities and collaborative volunteering, including committee work. Provide oversight of the room parent system.

Goals and Timeline for 2013-2014

- Foster networking among parents (e.g. Winter Potlucks, PIC Nightlife event and Summer Kindergarten Playdate)
- In collaboration with other committees, promote parent involvement in center-wide fundraisers and other events (ArtStart, Plant Sale, Wine & Cheese with Board, legislative/advocacy work)
- Promote connectedness and involvement among new parents through New Parent Mentor program
- Promote and communicate the benefits of volunteering, including PPP, committee participation, classroom involvement and fundraisers
- Leverage new PIC website to inform parents of specific volunteer opportunities and thank parents for their participation
- Recruit new members to the Parent Involvement Committee
- Continue oversight and monitoring of Room Parent System, review RP Guide as needed, engage lead teachers and continue to differentiate ASC from EL.
