Enrollment

- To enroll in PIC Summer Camp, return the attached form along with an application, a non-refundable application fee of \$35, and a tuition deposit of \$485. Your deposit will be applied to your child's last two weeks of camp. Application fee is waived for current PIC families.
- Upon receipt of the enrollment form, application, application fee and tuition deposit, we will send a packet of forms that must be completed and returned before your child comes to camp. A current (within 12 months) health form, signed by a physician, is required.
- Tuition for each additional session is due two weeks before the first day of the session.

Cancellation Policy: If you cancel between May 1 and May 15, you will receive a 75% refund. If you cancel between May 16 and May 31, you will receive a 50% refund. After May 31, payment is required for all sessions reserved, even if your child does not attend.
